Thank you for booking space with us at one or more of our events in the classic vehicle series of events. Please find enclosed relevant passes for all the shows you have booked to attend - you will receive no further correspondence from us, please distribute copies as necessary. Distribution of club passes prior to the event is the responsibility of the club stand co-ordinator NOT by the organiser at the gate on the day of the event. Vehicles arriving without passes will be charged the normal visitor rate and NO refunds will be issued. PLEASE do not lose your passes. Please note that the passes will be valid until 11.30am only on the day of the event, exhibitors arriving after this time will be charged the normal admission price.

- All our events are fully signposted
- Exhibitor gates open between 2pm - 7pm on the **day before** each event and from 7am on the event day (except Newbury Racecourse & Bodelwyddan Castle which are Sunday morning setup only)
- Display and trade vehicles are to be in place by 9.30am
- Please take directions from our stewards who are there to assist you and maintain site health and safety.
- Camping is available **only** at 2 day events (i.e. Blenheim and Capesthorpe) at £5 per tent/caravan/motorhome per night. (Traders - separate guidelines/camping allowed)
- No advertising notices permitted on enthusiasts pre-booked vehicles
- Rally plaques available from the commentator once the award ceremony has finished
- Concours awards are judged in the arena between 11-4pm by judges representing this organisation and whose decision is final
- All vehicles driving into the arena will be considered for concours judging
- To ensure fairness, the car of the show winner will be ineligible to win car of the show at future events.
- Clubs may use our events to promote their activities and recruit new members. Clubs must display a banner or board with their name clearly indicated.
- Traders and Autojumble must have valid insurance for their stock and the organiser does not accept loss of damage to stock however caused
- All vehicles on site must have valid insurance covering them for theft and damage - the organiser cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to any vehicle however caused

## Venue Locations

**Blenheim Palace, Woodstock, Oxon OX20 1PP** - Situated at Woodstock, 8 miles north of Oxford on the A44. From London & Birmingham it is signposted off the M40 at Junction 9. From Stratford follow the A3044 signs towards Oxford.

**Bath & West Showground, Shepton Mallet, Somerset BA4 6QN** - on the A371 between Shepton Mallet and Castle Cary.

**Bodelwyddan Castle, Rhyl, Denbighshire LL18 5UY** - 35 minutes from the M56 and M53, just off the A55 Expressway (J25), follow the brown and white signs.

**Capesthorpe Hall, Macclesfield, Cheshire SK11 9JY** - Situated on the A34 just south of Alderley Edge in the village of Siddington. 2 miles south of the Monks Heath traffic lights.

**Cholmondeley Castle, Cheshire SY14 8AH** - Situated on the Cheshire/Shropshire border on the A49 between Tarporley & Whitchurch.

**Cornbury Park** - located in the town of Charlbury, 15 miles from Oxford, easily accessible from the M40 junctions 9 and 10.

**Hoghton Tower, Nr Preston, Lancs PR5 0SH** - Situated on the A675 between Preston & Blackburn, 3 miles from J3 of the M65.

**Knebworth Park, Stevenage, Herts SG1 2AX** - Situated alongside the A1M at Junction 7.

**Loseley Park, Guildford, Surrey GU3 1HS** - just south of Guildford, 30 miles SW of London.

**Newbury Racecourse, Newbury, Berkshire RG14 7NZ** - In Newbury Town Centre on the old A34.

**Nostell Priory, near Wakefield, West Yorkshire WF4 1QE** - On A638 5 miles south east of Wakefield towards Doncaster.

**Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire CV8 2LZ** - After joining the A46 from the A45, take the exit signposted Stoneleigh NAC.

**Thoresby Park, Nr Ollerton, Notts NG22 9EP** - Thoresby Park is on the A614 Nottingham to Doncaster Road between the Ollerton R-A-B and the A1M R-A-B near Clumber Park.

**Three Counties Showground, Malvern, Worcs WR13 6NW** - Situated 10 miles from J7/8 of the M5 and J1 of the M50 - follow the brown tourist signs.

**Utttoxeter Racecourse** - situated just off the A50 between Burton on Trent and Stoke on Trent the racecourse is clearly signposted from the A50, A515, A518 and Utttoxeter Town Centre.
